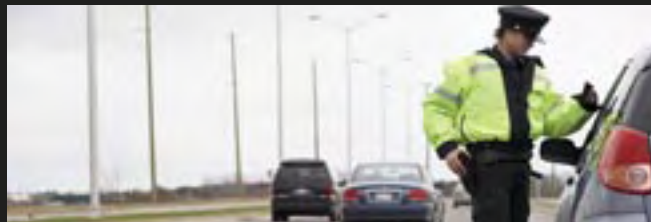

Virginia DUI / DWI drunk driving and Virginia reckless driving are Virginia Criminal Class 1 Misdemeanor charges carrying the possibility of up to one year imprisonment,

fines up to \$2500 and/or license suspensions. Some Virginia DUI / DWI cases require mandatory jail time upon convictions - these cases are termed “Virginia DUI/DWI Enhanced Punishment” cases.

DUI and Reckless Driving in Virginia

Drunk Driving

Virginia DUI/DWI is a class one misdemeanor criminal offense carrying the possibility of jail time.

There is a distinction between DWI and DUI if you are charged in a federal court such as the U.S. District Court in Alexandria. Under the Code of Federal Regulations, the body of law under which federal officers usually charge defendants, DUI reflects a blood alcohol content (BAC) between .02 and .08. DWI reflects a BAC of .08 and above. There is no distinction between DWI and DUI in state courts of the Commonwealth of Virginia.



Reckless Driving

Reckless driving is a Class 1 misdemeanor criminal charge - in the same classification as a DWI charge.

As stated clearly in the Code of Virginia, the penalty parameters for reckless driving is up to one year in jail, and/or up to \$2,500 in fines. Reckless driving also carries the possibility of a suspension of driving privileges for up to 6 months. The most common form of reckless driving is speeding 20+ mph over the speed limit.

Reckless Driving is also possible from the manner of driving if one operates a vehicle in a manner so as to endanger the life, limb, or property of any person.

Assisting Clients with Law, Science and Procedure

The Law Review: The law review encompasses an in-depth, continuing research of cases decided by the Courts of the United States and Virginia as these cases may set precedents in the law of criminal procedure, evidence, or other areas affecting the practice of criminal law. The Science Review: The science review encompasses a close examination of the Government’s blood, breath, physiological, chemical, radar, lidar, and other forensic evidence. Indeed, modern police equipment is only as accurate and reliable as internal tolerances and human factors allow. With the Firm’s in-depth understanding of the science behind the machines, creative defenses are possible to refute Government agents and police officers.

Procedural Review: The procedural review encompasses a thorough examination of the client’s interactions with the police or Government agents. The focus is on any infringement on the client’s U.S. and State Constitutional rights against self-incrimination, unlawful search and seizure, and freedom of expression. DUI and Reckless Driving cases are generally “heat of the moment” altercations as opposed to systematic investigations over a long period of time. Hence, the emotions and actions of the Government’s agents may run afoul of one’s rights. If this occurs, proper motions must be filed and argued in court to protect a client’s interests.
